## 1. Ground Water Recharging

Objectives: The aims of the ground water recharging in the campus is to abate the progressive depletion of ground water in Kendrapara district and also to combat unfavourable salt balance and saline water intrusion of ground water.

Context: Groundwater recharge can be defined as water added to the aquifer through the unsaturated zone after infiltration and percolation following any storm rainfall event. Problems: Funds may be raised for maintaining the pond for future uses. Provisions should be made to use the water for the drinking purpose
